# WASHINGTON STATE'S STSFA GRANT PROPOSAL

#### **STSFA Program overview:**

- FAST Act provides \$95 M for grants to states over next four years for alternative funding pilot projects
- > FHWA administers the program. Must obligate at least \$15 M by October 1, 2016.
- States must match 50% (in-kind, soft match and toll credits all acceptable)
- Competitive solicitation drew at least 7 proposals with a cumulative funding request exceeding \$20 M in year.
- > FHWA will be announcing their selections soon.

# WASHINGTON STATE'S STSFA GRANT PROPOSAL

#### **Washington's Proposal**

Seeks \$7.5 M (max award) to implement a statewide pilot as recommended by SC, with a few new features.

#### From 2015 Pilot Recommendations:

- Statewide test, 2,000 participants, 3 to 5 regions within the state
- Four different mileage reporting methods (including a time-based permit)
- A year-long test period to pick up any seasonal variations in travel patterns.

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# WASHINGTON STATE'S STSFA GRANT PROPOSAL

#### **Washington's Proposal**

Specific Unique Features in Washington's Proposal:

- International interoperability test with Surrey, B.C.
- A small-scale test of exchange of funds between two RUC systems (WA/OR), testing financial interoperability
- Special recruitment and participation from EV drivers through Seattle Electric Vehicle Association
- ► RUC pilot deployed in parallel with DOL's new vehicle system upgrades mutually beneficial
- Mobile phone app "hackathon" to solve a unique challenge: ability to deduct out-of-state miles

Western Road Usage Charge Consortium – (Washington, California, Colorado and Oregon for Planning; California and Oregon for live pilot)

I-95 Corridor Coalition – Delaware, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Vermont and New Hampshire.

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#### Recap:

Washington legislature re-appropriated \$500k of fed funds to WSTC to develop a pilot project implementation plan.

#### Status:

- WSTC issued RFQ and selected consultant team
- Contracting has been delayed while awaiting release of federal funds
- Transportation Committee Chairs will allow delivery by January 6, due to the delayed funding availability
- Revised target start date: August 1 (same as last year)

#### **Five Work Streams (broad tasks)**

- 1. Pilot Implementation Plan
- Identify essential agency roles in a pilot
- Review and finalize mileage reporting technologies and services to be tested
- Evaluate target number of pilot participants (demographics)
- Develop specific pilot evaluation criteria
- Develop a pilot project expenditure plan
- Develop a procurement strategy to deliver pilot project 3 services

- 2. Develop a Communications Plan:
- Develop a Participant Recruitment Plan
- > Develop a Plan to Communicate about the Pilot Launch

   Treasurer, Department of Revenue, WSDOT, DOL)
